



Virtual course on “ECVET AND MOBILITY”

A virtual course for stakeholders working with mobility
in VET and others interested in the topic

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course aims to help you starting up ECVET mobility activities. It introduces the main principles of ECVET and the demanded activities. The underlying information is to be found at this portal and in this manual. This tutorial is meant to put you on your way organising learning mobility with ECVET. Step by step the process of organising learning mobility will be amplified. The focus will be on the first stage of the organisation while this is fundamental in the process. The practical phase of actual mobility will be left aside.

It is recommendable to join and follow the course with one or more potential partners, in order to start up the ECVET mobility partnership. The course assists you to explore the partnership and to start the cooperation.

The course aims to stimulate reflection on practical experience in using ECVET and offers room for discussing the matter with each other. Based on best practices and European recommendations the course intends to enable its participants to explore the potential added value of ECVET in international mobility.

TARGET GROUP

This course is primarily addressed to those already working within vocational education and training and involved in mobility activities in the context of teaching and training. This includes trainers, teachers and education managers at private and public VET providers' and industry but also members of staff within competent bodies and social partner organisations involved in the implementation of vocational education elements such as international mobility as well as assessment and quality assurance that is effected by ECVET. Participants work in their daily work with a computer and are familiar with online tools.

SETUP OF THE COURSE

This course is an open online tutorial offering room to explore tools for your own context. It is free accessible in your own spare time with a facilitating discussion forum to discuss and get assistance from tutors and peer learners. There are 4 specific topics addressed with according assignments, published every week. In between participants have time to study the presentations, do the assignments by themselves or together with (potential) mobility partners and discuss the assignments with experts and other participants.

4. “what now?”- completion of the course
